

A message from Councillor John Havenhand on behalf of Findon Parish Council relating to the recent WSCC Traffic Regulation Order:

Please note that although Findon Councillors understood that the "TRO that will introduce 20mph speed limits through the village of Findon" the scheme as described has omitted to include Cissbury Ring Rd and the Quadrangle. In the opinion of Councillors the Cissbury Ring Rd is particularly dangerous as it is used regularly by ramblers, horses, cyclists and dog walkers - and there is no pavement. This will be raised at the FPC meeting on the 23rd October and the Council may make a formal request that they are included if possible and without delaying the 20mph scheme for the rest of the village. Residents of Findon can, of course, make their own personal response to WSCC on any matter pertaining to the TRO
