Councillor Alison Cooper, the Chair of Arun District Council, planted a Red Oak tree to commemorate the Coronation of King Charles III at Nightingales Sheltered Housing in Findon Village on Wednesday 20th September. Cllr Cooper was accompanied by Cllr Paul Bicknell and Mr Moh Hussein the Interim Head of Housing for Arun. The tree was purchased by the residents of Nightingales.

Nightingales is a Sheltered Housing Scheme in Findon village and comprises thirty flats and one bungalow and there are 37 residents. Nightingales is the only scheme in West Sussex where the Tenants Association manage some of the services under a Local Management Agreement. The services covered by the agreement are Cleaning, Grounds Maintenance and Minor Repairs. Chris Osborne-Shaw, Chair of NTA said "This has been our first year managing these services and we believe it has proved very successful. Our aim is to provide a high level of service using local contractors and to foster a greater sense of community. We hope to expand the services we manage in the years to come."
